

IWD FLOORBOARD

PURPOSE

IWD supplies Particle Flooring Board (Floorboard) for use as an internal floor or flooring substrate.

EXPLANATION

Floorboard is manufactured under pressure from wood-based particles and formaldehyde resin. The boards have tongue and groove edges and are available in dimensions (L x W x T, mm) of:

- 3600 x 900 x 19
- 3600 x 900 x 22
- 3600 x 600 x 25.

A wax solution is incorporated into the resin mix, allowing for greater edge protection if sheets are cut.

The manufacturer operates a Chain of Custody Management system that meets the requirements of AS 4707 Chain of Custody for Forest Based Products which is part of the Australian Forestry Certification Scheme.

The boards can also be used as general purpose board for DIY type applications.

SCOPE AND LIMITATIONS OF USE

Scope	Limitations
Building In buildings where the relevant part of the building complies with the NZ Building Code or where the designer and installer have satisfied themselves that the relevant part of the existing building is suitable for the intended building work. As a floor or flooring substrate.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Suitable for a floor loading up to 3 kPa in accordance with NZS 3604:2011. ➤ Installation must be no closer than 550 mm to the ground and at centres applicable to the thickness of the board, over timber or metal joists.
Flooring in wet areas or areas subject to water splash.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Must be covered with impervious membrane and sealed joints.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Floorboard must be installed in accordance with paragraph 7.2.1, 7.2.3.1 – 7.2.3.4 of NZS 3604:2011.

Maximum spacing of joists must be:

- 450 mm for 19 mm board, and
- 600 mm for 22 mm and 25 mm board.

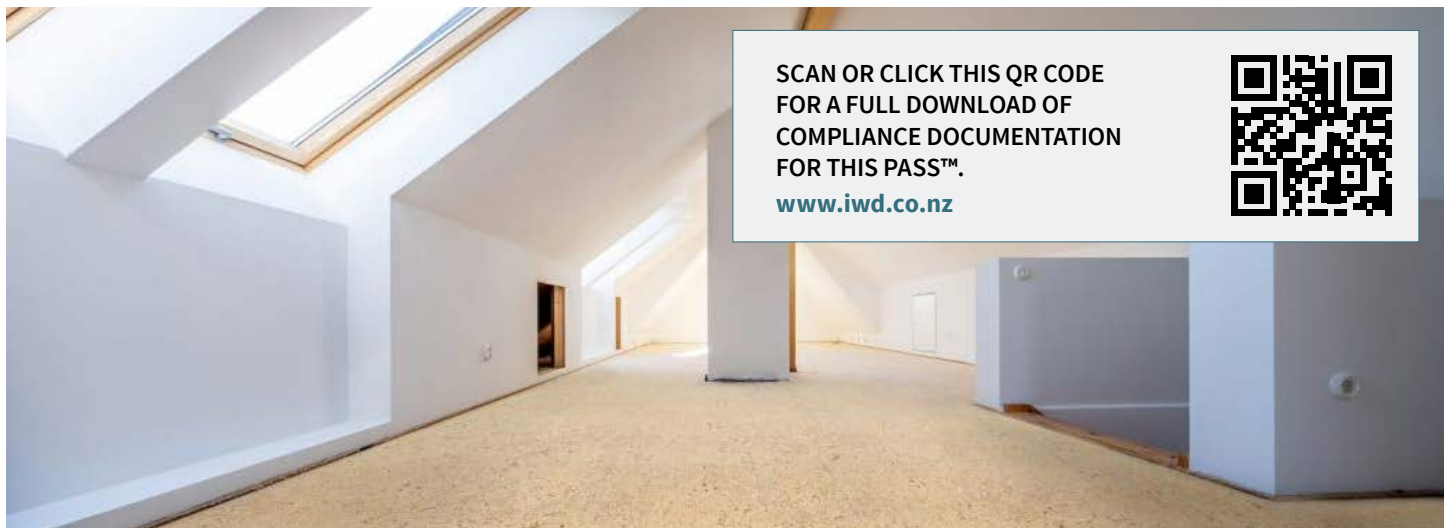
